- The competition is designed for **foreigners** residing in Poland. Direct addressees of the project are foreigners with B1-C1 language competence, especially those who live, learn and work in Lubuskie.
- The main objective of the competition is to share knowledge about Poland with other foreigners. The indirect goal is to integrate a group of foreigners who speak Polish, especially those who form a Lubuskie community, with low-level foreigners (including linguistic knowledge).

- 3. The task of the competition is to prepare a presentation on "Poland for me and for you", which contains visual material, and / or audio / video material and text for the recipient's- foreigner's needs at the beginner language level.
- The work should be sent by e-mail to: I.Palucka-Czerniak@ifp.uz.zgora.pl from 7 to 20 September 2017. If there is no reply, please phone 607- 522-498 within three working days.
- 5. The presentation must be complete and contain **a minimum of 20 slides** in a form that allows the audience to be exposed to it (e.g. **Microsoft PowerPoint**).
- 6. The presentation must be given a title, one author, and if you use someone else's content (such as web or books), you must provide the source of your photos and text.
- 7. In the application you must give the name and surname of the author, address of residence in Poland, telephone, e-mail, age and nationality.
- 8. The presentation may concern one of the specific topics:

- Beautiful places, wonderful people. My travels around Poland.

- Sometimes you have to go to the doctor. Medical care in Poland by the eyes of a foreigner.

- My rights and duties. Contact with police, army or gendarmerie in Poland.

- Knowledge is a treasure. Education world - Polish kindergartens, schools and universities.

- Active holidays in Poland, Lubuskie and surroundings.
- Interesting Polish traditions, stories, legends.
- Foreigner working in Poland rights, duties, opportunities and problems.
- I live here rent, buy an apartment in Poland.
- Polish language not so terrible.
- Polish culture and art can be enjoyed.
- Polish history I know and understand it.
- In the Polish office we will deal with it.
- 9. You can also choose another topic related to Poland, as well as with a specific region, for example Lubuskie. Personalized illustrations, photos, original written comments are welcome. The submitted works are not refundable; they remain in the resources of the Department of History and Pragmatics of Polish Language. ATTENTION: If you use

pictures of people, you must obtain written permission to publish their image on the web.

- 10. The jury composed of Elwira Topolnicka, Magdalena Jurewicz-Nowak, Iwona Pałucka-Czerniak will take into consideration the attractiveness of form, affordability, originality, correctness of language.
- 11. The prize in the competition is free admission to the Polish language course for foreigners at the advanced level for the authors of the top 10 presentations. The course is organized by the Institute of Polish Language at the University of Zielona Góra (30 hours) on the date agreed with the winners. It will be completed by the beginning of November 2017.
- 12. Selected presentations will be presented in class and posted on the website of the Polish Language Course for Foreigners.
- 13. Submission of the work for the competition is equivalent to acceptance of these regulations and consent to the processing of personal data for the purposes necessary for the implementation of the competition in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws of 2002 No. 101, item 926 as amended). If I receive a prize in the competition *Poland for me and for you* I agree to place my personal data (name and nationality) on Facebook and the website of the Institute of Polish Philology of the University of Zielona Góra, the website of the Polish Language Course for Foreigners at the University of Zielona Góra and the academic press. At the same time I was informed that the administrator of the personal data contest *Poland for me and for you* at the University of Zielona Góra is the University of Zielona Góra Institute of Polish Philology (Aleja Wojska Polskiego 69, 65-762 Zielona Góra). Data will only be processed to identify winners of the contest and will be voluntary. Data sharing is not foreseen. Contestants have the right to access the content of personal data and the right to correct them.
